broad and challenging curriculum

We offer an extensive range of subjects focusing on the academic, personal and social development of each individual student, with a strong emphasis on experiential learning. In the senior school these include the demanding HSC extension courses, the traditional range of academic subjects, and vocational and general interest electives. Students also have the opportunity to access TVET and other vocational alternatives.



gifted and talented program

In addition to our Selective Class program, students identified as being 'gifted' in one or more curriculum domains have the opportunity to participate in our gifted and talented program. Our qualified and enthusiastic teacher-coordinator has designed a series of G&T activity days where the students work individually and in teams to think outside the square and really challenge their abilities. Students also have opportunities to participate in academic competitions, Tournament of the Minds and faculty-organised days where identified students can deepen their understanding and skills in areas of special interest.

selective class

As one of the first comprehensive schools in NSW to introduce a selective class program, we recognise the importance of responding to the very particular needs of gifted and talented learners. Students in a Selective Class complete a differentiated curriculum in the core program, enabling them to meet all relevant NSW syllabus requirements, while also being extended in breadth and depth of study in each course. Our gifted and talented students also have opportunities to participate in a range of enriching activities to further enliven their learning growth.

Entry into the Selective Class is based on the results of a placement test carried out in February, as well as the advice received from each student's primary school.

shared values – individual growth

At Heathcote we foster a commitment to social harmony and social responsibility in our students.
